## Submission of Abstracts

Abstracts should be written in font Arial 10pt.

### Structure of abstracts

Abstracts should comprise the following elements, with each beginning a new paragraph:

**Title:** The abstract title should be in bold initial capital/lower case, not all capitals. The abstract title should be no more than 20 words.

**Authors:** Authors' names should be supplied in the surname-last format and should be in initial capital/lower case, not all capitals, with the presenting author underlined. Institutional affiliations should be indicated with superscript numbers following the author name.

**Affiliation:** All affiliations should contain institution, city and country.

**Abstract text:** Maximum length of abstract text is 250 words. Sub-headings e.g. Introduction, Method, Results, etc. may be included if required.

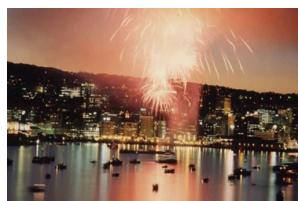
**References:** Preferably no references. Abbreviations should be used only for common terms. For uncommon terms, the abbreviation should be given in brackets after the first full use of the word.

Tables, diagrams and graphs CANNOT be accepted in the abstract submission. This is due to the limitations of the computer software program.

To ensure consistency in formatting, all abstracts are to be submitted in Microsoft Word.

**Time allocation required:** A time allocation may be requested but this cannot be guaranteed and is at the discretion of the Organising Committee.

**Abstracts must be submitted no later than Friday 27th May 2011. It is planned to publish abstracts in the Australasian Journal of Dermatology.**

### Dr David de Berker

My research interest are clinically oriented and directed around disorders and biology of hair and nail, skin cancer and the surgical treatments of skin cancer.

I have been local lead investigator in 7 multicentre RCTs trials in the last 10 years

Chair of the South West Cancer Intelligence Service panel on skin cancer, Chair of the Avon, Somerset and Wiltshire Cancer network, Clinical Advisor to the South West Public Health Observatory and Lead clinician for skin cancer at University Hospitals Bristol.

President of the European Nail Society and author on more than 50 articles, chapter, and books on nail disease.



### Dr Fowler

Joseph F. Fowler, Jr. MD Clinical Professor of Dermatology University of Louisville Dermatology Specialists PSC Louisville, KY Dr. Fowler is an internationally known dermatologist, recognized for his work in the field of contact and occupational dermatology.

He has maintained a busy private practice for 24 years in Louisville, Ky., and is a clinical professor of dermatology at the University of Louisville. He has been a past president of the American Contact Dermatitis Society, the Space Dermatology Foundation, and the Kentucky Dermatology Society. He is President of the North American Contact Dermatitis Group. He is listed in Woodward and White's "Best Doctors in America". He is a fellow of the American Academy of Dermatology and member of numerous professional organizations. Dr. Fowler is the Founder and Chairman of the Caribbean Dermatology Symposium. He has been an invited lecturer at many regional, national, and international medical conferences, including the annual conference of the American Academy of Dermatology each year since 1989. He is the author or coauthor of over 110 scholarly publications and medical chapters and the co-author, with Bob Rietschel MD, of "Fisher's Contact Dermatitis" one of the most used dermatology textbooks.

Dr. Fowler has served as principal investigator on multiple pharmaceutical studies with a special concentration in treatments for atopic eczema, contact dermatitis, skin cancer, psoriasis, acne, and other dermatoses. He is a consultant for a number of dermatologic companies.
